FACILITIES FOR DIFFERENTLY-ABLED

Barrier-Free Environment

The institution is committed to ensuring a physically accessible and inclusive environment for all. Ramps, handrails, and non-slippery flooring are provided at all major entry and exit points to facilitate smooth movement for wheelchair users. Elevators with Braille buttons and auditory signals are installed in multi-storey buildings. Accessible washrooms are available in all major blocks, and reserved parking spaces are designated near entrances for persons with disabilities. Signage in Braille and tactile pathways assist visually impaired individuals in navigating the campus independently.

Academic Support

Assistive technologies such as screen readers, magnifiers, and speech-to-text software are provided for visually and hearing-impaired students and teachers. Study materials and question papers are made available in accessible formats such as Braille, large print, or digital text. Extra time and scribe assistance are arranged during examinations as per university norms. Classroom seating arrangements are designed to meet the specific needs of differently-abled individuals.

Support Services

A Disability Support Cell functions to address the needs, rights, and welfare of differently-abled persons in the institution. Counselling and guidance services are available to support academic, emotional, and social well-being. Regular awareness and sensitivity programs are conducted for students, teachers, and staff to promote inclusivity and empathy.

Employment and Equal Opportunity

The institution ensures non-discrimination in recruitment, promotion, and participation in all institutional activities. Reasonable accommodations such as flexible schedules, ergonomic furniture, and accessible teaching aids are made available to differently-abled teachers to facilitate effective teaching and professional growth.
